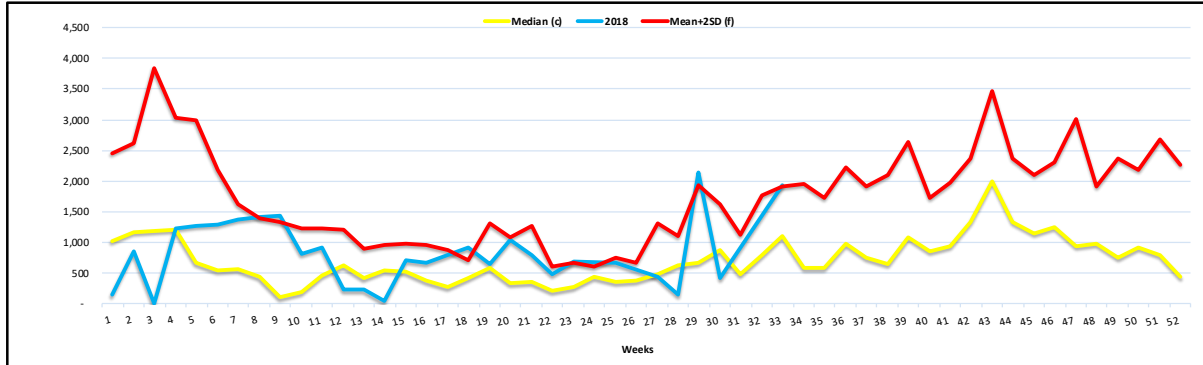


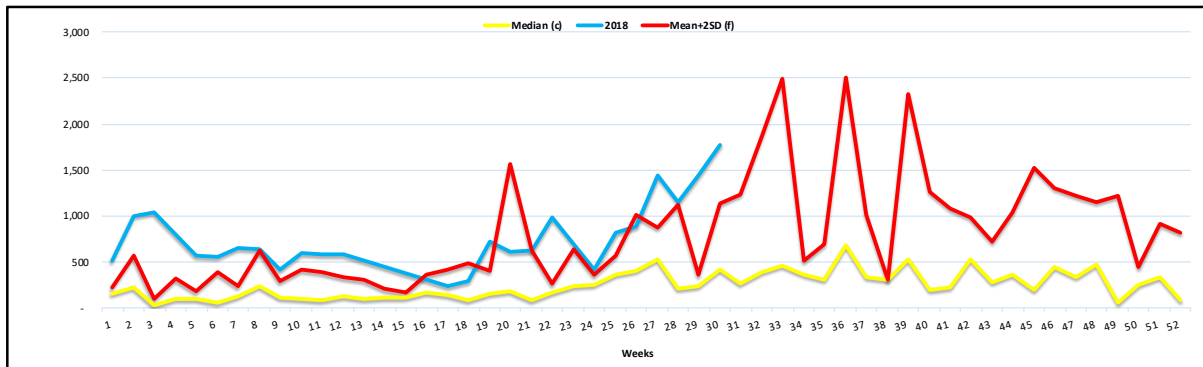
Malaria trends by county Republic of South Sudan, as of week 33, 2018
