### a) EVD SITUATIONAL UPDATE IN UGANDA

- There is NO confirmed EVD case in Uganda.
- Active case search continues in all communities, health facilities and on formal and informal border crossing in all districts especially in the high-risk ones.
- Alert cases continue to be picked, isolated, treated and blood samples picked for testing by the Uganda Virus Research Institute (UVRI). The alerts are highlighted in the specific district reports below under the Surveillance section.
- b) PREPAREDNESS IN THE FIELD (PROGRESS AND GAPS)

#### COORDINATION

#### **Kasese District**

#### **Achievements**

- There was a District Task Force (DTF) meeting that agreed on the following action points:
  - The Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to write to all heads of department reminding them to always attend this meeting.
  - COA write to the Permanent Secretaries of MoH and Ministry of Internal Affairs about the utility bills at Mpondwe Point of Entry (PoE).



- The District Education Officer to write a memo to schools not use the chlorine supplied in schools until training takes places.
- WASH/Chlorine team will be given more training on chlorine mixing with support from UNICEF.
- The CAO will write to Medical Superintendent of Bwera Hospital to properly maintain hygiene and temperature screening at the hospital.
- The District Health Educator to finalize verification of participant's lists who attended the CBDS training from sub-counties for payment by WHO.
- The DHO to make a calendar of all DTF meetings and submit to CAO, RDC and LCV
  Chairman to facilitate their attendance in the meetings.

## RISK COMMUNICATION AND SOCIAL MOBILIZATION

#### **Kasese District**

- WHO/UNICEF conducted a Continuing Medical Education session at Kilembe Mines Hospital attended by 58 health workers (38 females, 20 males) including medical students and support staff. Discussed EVD message delivery at all service points.
- Chlorinated water will be used in all hand washing facilities; security guards to enforce hand washing by all visitors and patients entering the hospital.
- All hospital staff to exercise precautions, intensify surveillance and share reports with DHOs office.
