## HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (19/09/2020)

- A total of 10377 cases have been recorded in a population of approximately 2.5 Million people, making it about 0.4% of the population infected.
- More male cases 5543 (53.4%) were recorded compared to female cases 4834 (46.6%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 432 (4.2%) Health Care Workers (HCWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 to-date.
  - 292 (67.6%) State; 139 (32.2%) Private, 1 (0.2%) NGO
- Today (19/09/2020), 64 recoveries have been recorded from 4 regions; the recovery rate now stands at 77.4%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions are reporting the highest with 4903 (47.2%) and 3769 (36.3%) respectively.




Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases 19 September 2020

- To date, 87681 tests (including 4974 re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, and UNAM laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 22143 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 90 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 8 regions.
- Cumulatively, 12157 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 1698 (17.3%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 7402 (75.5%) out of 9800 active contacts were monitored.




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases
As of 19 September 2020

- Up to 2123 (20.5%) of the total cases were recorded during week 34 (Figure 1).
- After a peak in epi-week 34, the country has seen a gradual reduction in the mean number of confirmed cases from 303 to 147 in epi-week 37.
- Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily. Today, 946 calls were answered including 8 alerts.

- The 20-49 years age-brackets constitute **7550** (**72.8%**) of the confirmed cases, while a sizable proportion of the 50-59 age group is **1106** (**10.7%**).
- Among those aged 30-39 years, a significant proportion of males, 1575 (54.8%) are infected more than females 1297 (45.2%).
- The under 5 years make up 241 (2.3%) of the total cases.
- Aged 60 years and above constitute 471 (4.5%) of the confirmed cases.

- Since March 2020, 13152 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 854 people are currently in quarantine with 18 new admissions in the past 24 hours.




Figure 3: Distribution of suspected and confirmed COVID-19 cases in Namibia by District as of 19 September 2020

## PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION(S)

- Weekly engagements with regions to ensure readiness for effective response.
- Public awareness on COVID-19 prevention measures is ongoing.
- Efforts on expanding the National testing capacity are ongoing.
- Response strategies for post State of Emergency are underway.

## CHALLENGES

- Large data backlog awaiting entry into excel data base and DHIS2.
- Inadequate ICU facilities and ICU equipment at referral hospitals and high care units in the districts.
- Inadequate isolation units, at health facilities in the regions.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

- Fast tracking of efforts to use DHIS2 national-wide.
- Provision of fully equipped ICU facilities at referral hospitals and high care units in the districts.
- Establish fully equipped isolation units at health facilities in the regions.
