- A total of 11891 cases have been recorded in a population of approximately 2.5 Million people, making it about 0.5% of the population infected.
- More male cases 6454 (54.3%) were recorded compared to female cases 5437 (45.7%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 470 (4.0%) Health Care Workers (HCWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 todate.
 - 305 (64.9%) State; 162 (34.5%) Private, 3 (0.6%) NGO
- Today (09/10/2020), 29 recoveries have been recorded from 4 regions region; the recovery rate now stands at 82.5%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 5527 (46.5%) and 3881 (32.6%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 99 (77.3%) are COVID-19 deaths while 29 (22.7%) are COVID-19 related deaths.
- There is an alarming increase in the number of COVID-19 positive cases in closed settings such as schools, police holding cells and prisons.

- To date, 107399 tests (including 5716 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM and Namib Poultry laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 27863 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 268 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 8 regions.
- Cumulatively, 18900 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 2831 (31.4%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 7801 (86.4%) out of 9026 active contacts were monitored.




Figure 1: Distribution of suspected and confirmed COVID-19 cases by District, 09 October 2020




Figure 2: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, As of 09 October 2020

- The 20-49 years age-brackets constitute 8503 (71.5%) of the confirmed cases, while a sizable proportion of the 50-59 age group is 1221 (10.3%).
- A total of 1332 (11.2%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- Among those aged 30-39 years, a significant proportion of males, 1804 (55.9%) are infected more than females 1425 (44.1%).
- The under 5 years make up 294 (2.5%) of the total cases.
- Aged 60 years and above constitute 541 (4.5%) of the confirmed cases.

- Up to 2123 (17.9%) of the total cases were recorded during week 34 (Figure 2).
- After a peak in epi-week 34, the country has seen a gradual reduction in the average number of confirmed cases from 303 to 85 in epi-week 40.
- Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily. Today, 854 calls were answered including 112 alerts.




Figure 3: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, As of 09 October 2020

- > Training on Integrated Disease Surveillance Response (IDSR) is ongoing country-wide.
- Public awareness on COVID-19 prevention measures is ongoing.
- Response strategies for post State of Emergency are underway.
- > The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise continuation of essential health services

CHALLENGES

- Lack of isolation units and facilities in the country for special cases in closed settings such as police holding cells and prisons.
- Inadequate ICU facilities and ICU equipment at referral hospitals and high care units in the districts.


RECOMMENDATIONS


- Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities for identified special cases throughout the country.
