# **HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (10/10/2020)**

- A total of 11936 cases have been recorded in a population of approximately 2.5 Million people, making it about 0.5% of the population infected.
- More male cases 6472 (54.2%) were recorded compared to female cases 5464 (45.8%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 473 (4.0%) Health Care Workers (HCWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 todate.
  - 307 (64.9%) State; 163 (34.5%) Private, 3 (0.6%) NGO
- Today (10/10/2020), 10 recoveries have been recorded from 3 regions region; the recovery rate now stands at 82.2%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 5552 (46.5%) and 3885 (32.5%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 99 (77.3%) are COVID-19 deaths while 29 (22.7%) are COVID-19 related deaths.
- There is an alarming increase in the number of COVID-19 positive cases in closed settings such as schools, police holding cells and prisons.

- To date, 108743 tests (including 5759 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM and Namib Poultry laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 28022 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 159 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 9 regions.
- Cumulatively, 20442 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 2839 (37.1%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 6382 (83.4%) out of 7648 active contacts were monitored.




Figure 1: Distribution of suspected and confirmed COVID-19 cases by District, 10 October 2020




Figure 2: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, As of 10 October 2020

- The 20-49 years age-brackets constitute 8518 (71.4%) of the confirmed cases, while a sizable proportion of the 50-59 age group is 1230 (10.3%).
- A total of 1347 (11.3%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- Among those aged 30-39 years, a significant proportion of males, 1805 (55.8%) are infected more than females 1427 (44.2%).
- The under 5 years make up 296 (2.5%) of the total cases.
- Aged 60 years and above constitute 545 (4.6%) of the confirmed cases.

- Up to 2123 (17.8%) of the total cases were recorded during week 34 (Figure 2).
- After a peak in epi-week 34, the country has seen a gradual reduction in the average number of confirmed cases from 303 to 85 in epi-week 40.
- Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily. Today, 854 calls were answered including 112 alerts.




Figure 3: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, As of 10 October 2020

## PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION(S)

- Ministry of Health and Social Services continue to receive donations from partners.
- > Training on Integrated Disease Surveillance Response (IDSR) is ongoing country-wide.
- Public awareness on COVID-19 prevention measures is ongoing.
- Response strategies for post State of Emergency are underway.
- > The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise continuation of essential health services

### **CHALLENGES**

- Lack of isolation units and facilities in the country for special cases in closed settings such as police holding cells and prisons.
- Inadequate ICU facilities and ICU equipment at referral hospitals and high care units in the districts.

### RECOMMENDATIONS

- Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities for identified special cases throughout the country.
- Provision of fully equipped ICU facilities at referral hospitals and high care units in the districts.
