- A total of 41200 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- More male cases 20837 (51%) were recorded compared to female cases 20363 (49%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1849 (4%) are Health Workers (HWs).
 - 1447 (78%) State; 398 (22%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 1749 (95%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 93%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 15735 (38%) and 7631 (19%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 364 (79%) are COVID-19 deaths while 94 (21%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SITUATION IN NAMIBIA




Figure 1: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases 13 March 2021

- Of the total confirmed cases, 26848 (65%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of **6584 (16%)** of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 934 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2589 (6%) are above 60 years of age.

To date, **319398** tests (including **11653** retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry,

Diagno, NAMPath and Central Veterinary laboratories.



Since the beginning of the outbreak, 74225 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 95 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 7 regions.

- Cumulatively, 70085 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 10258 (25%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 1594 (41%) out of 3912 active contacts monitored.




Figure 3: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 13 March 2021

RECOMMENDATIONS


Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.
