- A total of 67 021 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 3% of the total population (2 550 226).
- More female cases 34 682 (52%) have been recorded compared to male cases 32 339 (48%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 2 861 (4%) are Health Workers.
- 2 281 (80%) State; 575 (20%) Private, 5 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
- 2 490 (87%) recoveries and 10 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 83%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 25 645 (38%) and 10 568 (16%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 882 (85%) are COVID-19 deaths while 158 (15%) are COVID-19 related deaths. The case fatality rate now stands at 2%.

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SITUATION IN NAMIBIA




Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, 14 June 2021

- The highest peak of 6 723 (10%) cases was recorded during week 23'of 2021 (Figure 1).
- The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.
- Today (14/06/2021), 814 calls were answered including 15 alerts.




Figure 2: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 14 June 2021

- Of the total confirmed cases, 41 546 (62%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 11 362 (17%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 1 487 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 5 178 (8%) are above 60 years of age.




Figure 3: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases 14 June 2021

- Since March 2020, 53 636 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 2 389 people are currently in quarantine, with 699 new admissions.

- To date, 469 685 tests (including 12 387 re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath, Namibia Central Pathology, High Care and Central Veterinary laboratories
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 102 788 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 706 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 11 regions.
- Cumulatively, 97 226 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while 134 contacts are lost to follow-up and a total of 15 365 (23%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 1 039 (22%) out of 4 752 active contacts were monitored.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION (S)

- The COVID-19 vaccination programme is ongoing throughout the country
- The government and development partners continue to prioritize the continuation of essential health services.

CHALLENGES

Non-adherence to COVID-19 Infection Prevention and Control (IPC) measures by the general public.

Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID-19 IPC measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.
