HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (09/05/2021)

- A total of 50209 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- Cases are equally distributed by gender at 50%.
- Of the total confirmed cases, 2165 (4%) are Health Workers.
 - 1702 (79%) State; 459 (21%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 2064 (95%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- > The recovery rate now stands at 94%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 17791 (35%) and 8801 (18%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 567 (82%) are COVID-19 deaths while 124 (18%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

- Of the total confirmed cases, 31482 (63%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 8866 (18%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 1144 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 3386 (7%) are above 60 years of age.





Figure 1: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases 09 May 2021



- To date, 397999 tests (including 11979 re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath, Namibia Central Pathology, High Care and Central Veterinary laboratories
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 90458 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 110 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 11 regions.
- Cumulatively, 86535 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 12580 (25%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 1034 (31%) out of 3314 active contacts monitored.




Figure 3: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, 09 May 2021

- The highest peaks of 3463 (7%) and 3485 (7%) cases were recorded during week 53 of 2020 and 1 of 2021 respectively (Figure 3).
- The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.
- Today (09/05/2021), 434 calls were answered including 21 alerts.

- A total of 1273 people are currently in quarantine, with 4 new admissions.
