## HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (18/05/2021)

- A total of 51827 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- Cases are equally distributed by gender at 50%.
- Of the total confirmed cases, 2245 (4%) are Health Workers.
  - 1768 (79%) State; 464 (21%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
  - 2115 (94%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 94%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 18511 (36%) and 8950 (17%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 612 (83%) are COVID-19 deaths while 127 (17%) are COVID-19 related deaths.




Figure 1: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 18 May 2021

Since March 2020, 47479 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.

A total of 1049 people are currently in quarantine, with 177 new admissions.




Figure 2: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, 18 May 2021

The highest peaks of 3463 (7%) and 3485 (7%) cases were recorded during week 53 of 2020 and 1 of 2021 respectively (Figure 2).

The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.

Today (18/05/2021), **557** calls were answered including **9** alerts.

- To date, **411300** tests (including **12031** re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath, Namibia Central Pathology, High Care and Central Veterinary laboratories
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 93166 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 473 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 14 regions.
- Cumulatively, 89449 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 13233 (26%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 1200 (41%) out of 2938 active contacts were monitored.

- Of the total confirmed cases, 32438 (63%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 9017 (17%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 1170 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 3624 (7%) are above 60 years of age.




Figure 3: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases 18 May 2021
