A total of 53603 cases have been recorded to-date, representations.	presenting 2% of the population.

- More female cases 27081 (51%) have been recorded compared to male cases 26522 (49%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 2339 (4%) are Health Workers.
 - 1856 (79%) State; 479 (20%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 2213 (95%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 93%.
- > All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 19180 (36%) and 9141 (17%) respectively.
- ▶ Of the total fatalities, 655 (83%) are COVID-19 deaths while 134 (17%) are COVID-19 related deaths.



- To date, 421269 tests (including 12112 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath, Namibia Central Pathology, High Care and Central Veterinary laboratories
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 94932 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 246 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 11 regions.
- Cumulatively, 91185 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 13548 (25%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.



The under 5 years age group make up 1227 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 3875 (7%) are above 60 years of age.





Figure 1: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases 25 May 2021



Cumulative_ confirmed cases per 100 000 people




- Since March 2020, 48934 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 1656 people are currently in quarantine, with 137 new admissions.

- The highest peaks of 3463 (7%) and 3485 (7%) cases were recorded during week 53 of 2020 and 1 of 2021 respectively (Figure 3).
- The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.
- Today (25/05/2021), 519 calls were answered including 5 alerts.
