HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (11/06/2021)



- A total of **64 025** cases have been recorded to-date, representing **3%** of the total population (**2 550 226**).
- More female cases **33 101 (52%)** have been recorded compared to male cases **31 104 (48%)**.
- Of the total confirmed cases, **2 785 (4%)** are Health Workers.
- **2 216 (80%)** State; **564 (20%)** Private, **5 (0.2%)** Non-Governmental Organizations.
- **2213 (79%)** recoveries and **10 (0.4%)** deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at **85%**.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; **Khomas** and **Erongo** regions reported the highest with **24 713 (39%)** and **10 172 (16%)** respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, **841 (85%)** are COVID-19 deaths while **152 (15%)** are COVID-19 related deaths. The case fatality rate now stands at **2%**.

➤ Today (11/06/2021), **807** calls were answered including **12** alerts.

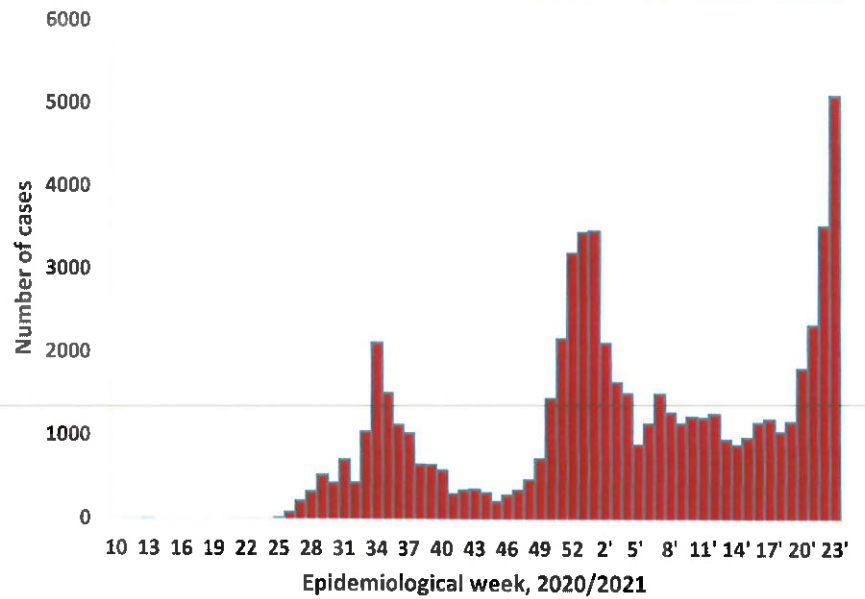
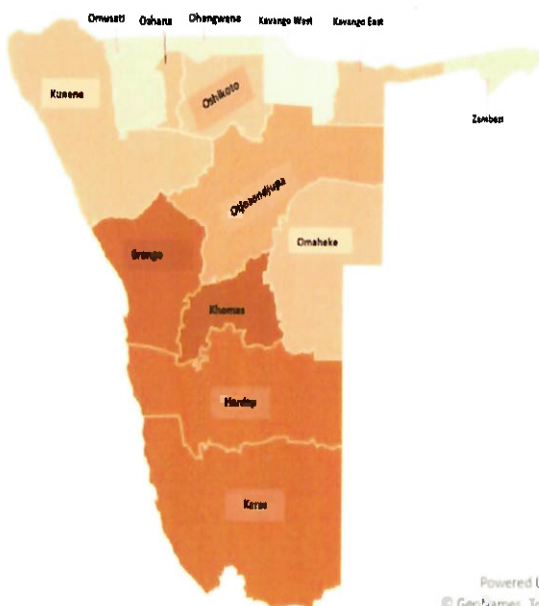


Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, 11 June 2021

Cumulative_confirmed cases per 100 000 people

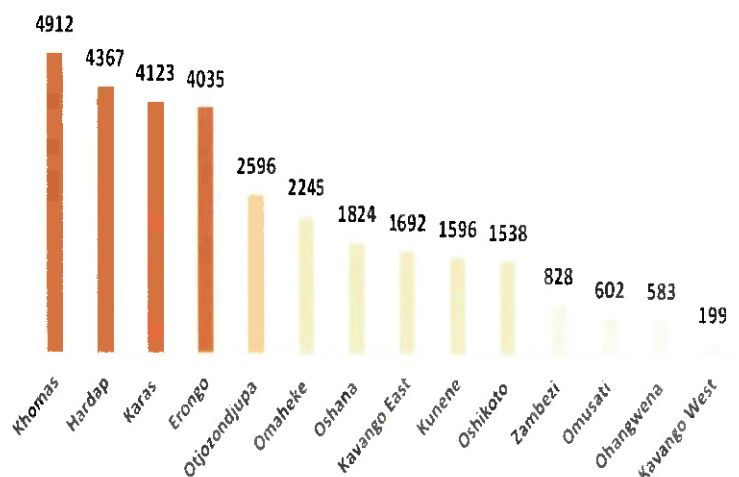


Figure 2: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 11 June 2021

- Of the total confirmed cases, **39 895 (62%)** are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of **10 749 (17%)** of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up **1 421 (2%)** of the total cases whereas, **4 919 (8%)** are above 60 years of age.

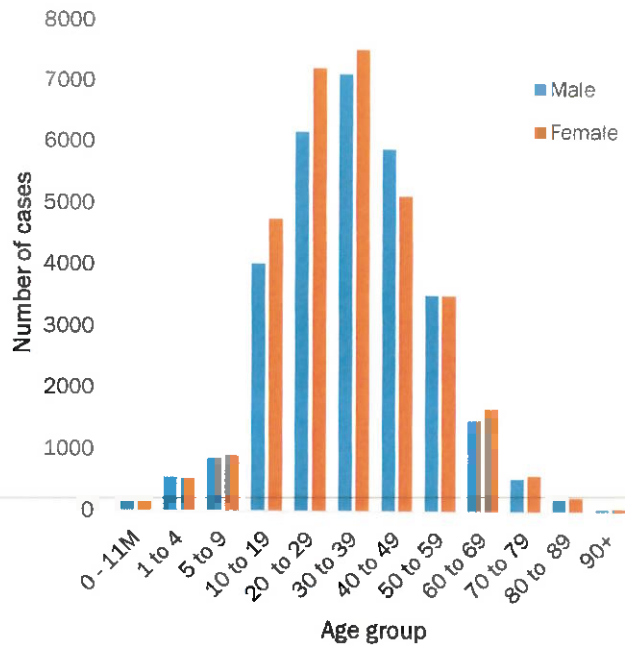


Figure 3: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases 11 June 2021

- Since March 2020, **52 923** people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of **2 126** people are currently in quarantine, with **147** new admissions.

- To date, **462 299** tests (including **12 338** re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath, Namibia Central Pathology, High Care and Central Veterinary laboratories
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, **101 809** contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, **757** new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 9 regions.
- Cumulatively, **96 360** contacts have completed their monitoring period, while **134** contacts are lost to follow-up and a total of **15 209 (24%)** contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, **2 229 (48%)** out of **4660** active contacts were monitored.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION (S)

- The COVID-19 vaccination programme is ongoing throughout the country
- The government and development partners continue to prioritize the continuation of essential health services.

CHALLENGE

- Non-adherence to COVID-19 Infection Prevention and Control (IPC) measures by the general public.

RECOMMENDATION

- Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID-19 IPC measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.
